Open Your Heart's COVID-19 Response Fund: In an effort to ensure that homeless service providers and food shelves were able to plan, prepare and respond to COVID-19, Open Your Heart quickly provided emergency funding towards plans to protect the homeless and give them a place to recover in isolation.
